National Flag Day

Flag Day also called National Flag Day in the United States a day honoring the national flag observed on June 14th. The holiday commemorates the date in 1777 when the United States approve the design for its first national flag . The idea to set aside a day to honor the national flag came from several sources. Bernard J. Cigrand a Wisconsin school teacher in 1885 urged his students to observe June 14th as “Flag Birth-day”. He later wrote an essay published in a Chicago newspaper that date as the day to celebrate the flag. In 1888 William T. Kerr of Pennsylvania Founded the American Flag Day Association of Western Pennsylvania an organization to which he claim is that of George Morris of Pennsylvania who is said to have organized the first formal celebration of the day in Hanford in 1861. In 1916 president Woodrow Wilson proclaimed June 14th as an official Federal Holiday. In 1949 the US Congress permanently established the date's National Flag Day. Although Flag Day is not An official State Holiday Pennsylvania celebrates the day as a State Holiday. Each year the U.S. President delivers an address that proclaims the week of June 14th as National Flag Week and all Americans are encouraged to fly US flags during that week . So come on Model A Club lets get those flags out and fly them proudly that week and every week.



Strawberry Cream Cheese French Toast



Prep	Cook	Ready In
30 m	1 h 15 m	9 h 45 m

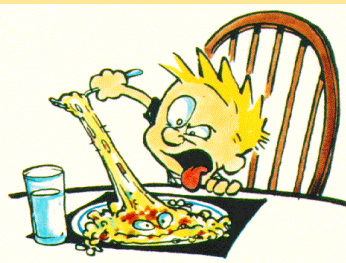
"French toast casserole is served with a drizzle of warm homemade strawberry sauce."

Ingredients

12 slices home-style white bread, cut into 1-inch cubes, divided	Sauce:
2 (8 ounce) packages cold cream cheese, cut into 1-inch cubes	1 cup white sugar
1 1/2 cups sliced fresh strawberries	1 cup water
2 cups half-and-half	2 tablespoons cornstarch
12 large eggs	1 cup sliced fresh strawberries
1/3 cup pure maple syrup	1 tablespoon butter

Directions

1. Generously grease a 9x13-inch baking dish.
2. Arrange half the bread cubes in the prepared baking dish. Evenly distribute cream cheese cubes over the bread cube layer; sprinkle 1 1/2 cups sliced strawberries atop cream cheese layer. Layer the remaining bread cubes over strawberry layer.
3. Pour half-and-half into a blender; pulse for a few seconds. Blend eggs into half-and-half until fully incorporated. Add maple syrup and blend until smooth. Pour mixture evenly over bread mixture. Cover the baking dish with aluminum foil and refrigerate 8 hours or overnight.
4. Remove baking dish from refrigerator 45 minutes before baking.
5. Preheat oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C).
6. Bake the covered casserole in the preheated oven for 30 minutes. Remove aluminum foil and continue baking until French toast is puffed and golden brown, about 30 more minutes.
7. Stir sugar, water, and cornstarch together in a small saucepan. Cook, stirring occasionally, over medium heat until mixture has thickened, about 5 minutes. Mix in 1 cup sliced strawberries; cook and stir until strawberries have softened, about 10 minutes. Add butter; stir until melted. Serve hot over French toast.

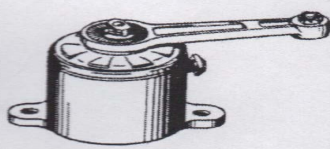

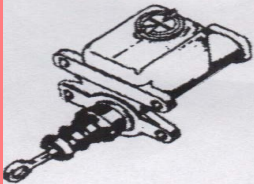

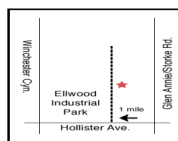
