Differences between the NOS and Reproducton Plugs: 3X on the Porcelain of the NOS plug has a rounded top 3; the repro plug has a flat top 3. Knurling on the base of the NOS plug goes all the way to the bottom; repro plug knurling does not. NOS box has red end flaps and does not mention Model B; repro box has blue end flap and mentions A, B. NOS box front says "Dependable"; repro box front says "Guaranteed Dependable". Nothing Pie

Ingredients: 20 Ritz crackers, crushed 3/4 cup pecans 3 egg whites, beaten stiff 1/2 teaspoon baking powder 1 cup sugar

1 teaspoon vanilla

Preparation:

Crush Ritz crackers and pecans separately, then combine. Mix well and set aside. Beat the egg whites until soft peaks form. Add baking powder, beat again, then slowly beat in the sugar, then the vanilla. Combine with cracker mixture, stir well and pour into pie pan. Preheat oven to 325° F. Bake for 30 minutes. Serve!
