

#### Caramel Apple Topping (from Christine)

This is one of the simplest & most delicious ways to prepare fresh apples. Keep a jar on hand to serve over cake, ice cream, pound cake or yogurt, with your morning granola or straight out of the jar with a spoon at two in the morning when you find yourself alone & hungry!

4 sliced apples; no need to peel 1tsp. cinnamon
4 TBLP Butter (no substitute)
A pinch of nutmeg
1 cup brown sugar
1 cup cream or buttermilk

Melt the butter in a heavy pan. Add the sugar & swirl until melted. Add the spices & apples & saute' until the apples are tender. Add the walnuts & stir. Turn off the heat, & slowly stir in the cream. Serve immediately over ice cream or cake & keep the leftovers in a jar in the fridge. (Source: Traditional)
