Mix all ingredients in a bowl using a spoon or hand whisk. 1.

- Pour into a greased and floured pie plate (about 8 9 inches size) and bake 350 F or 180 C or Gas 4 oven for 45 minutes. I place my pie in a 2. baking tray in case of spills.
- 3. When done, the pie will be slightly wobbly in the center. Remove from the oven, allow to cool, then refrigerate overnight if possible.
- 4 Serve on its own or with a blob of vanilla ice cream!


